

Contest Rules and Regulations for

 IIHF 2013 Women's World Championship Classroom Participation (the "Contest") The Contest is sponsored by the Canadian Hockey Association operating as Hockey Canada (the "Contest Sponsor")

Please carefully read these Contest Rules and Regulations (the "Rules") in their entirety before entering the Contest. Please do not enter the Contest unless you have read and agree to be legally bound by these Rules. Participation in the Contest constitutes your full and unconditional agreement to and acceptance of these Rules, which are final and binding (without right of appeal) on all matters relating to the Contest.

- 2. **Contest Dates** The Contest will commence on Friday September 21, 2012 at 12:00:01 a.m. Eastern Standard Time and will conclude on Sunday March 31, 2013 at 11:59:59 p.m. Eastern Standard time (the "Contest Period"). The sole determinant of the time for the purposes of determining the validity of an entry will be the server machine(s) of the Contest Sponsor.
- 3. **How to Enter:** No purchase necessary. Entries may be made **online** by following the links and on-screen instructions at www.hockeycanada.ca/school program. To be eligible for all prizing, Entrants must register online, and entries must be received within the Contest Period. All registered classrooms will automatically be entered for all prizing. Participants making multiple entries will be disqualified. Entries that are fraudulent are not permitted and will be declared invalid. All entries that are incomplete, tampered with, submitted through illicit means, or do not conform to or satisfy any condition of these rules will be declared invalid. All entries become the sole property of the Contest Sponsor and the 2013 Women's World Host Organizing Committee and will not be acknowledged or returned. The Contest Sponsor is not responsible for late, lost, misdirected, delayed, incomplete or incompatible entries.

4. Who Can Enter

a. The **Contest** is open to all classrooms in district school boards and school authorities in the Province of Ontario. Registration must be made by the teacher (the "Entrant"), in the teacher's legal name, on behalf of the class. Any Entrant who wins will be required to show proof of identification that may include a driver's license or other form of picture identification as part of the verification process. The Contest Sponsor reserves the right, in its sole and absolute discretion, to require proof of identity and/or eligibility in a form acceptable to the Contest Sponsor to participate in this Contest. Failure to provide such proof may result in disqualification.

Teachers from outside of the province of Ontario are permitted to register their class to gain access to teaching resources but <u>will not be eliqible for the Contest Prizes</u>.

Prizing

Teacher Recognition Prize

- 5. All Entrants who complete the online registration form will be eligible for a teacher recognition prize. Online registration forms must be completed in full in order to be eligible.
 - a. One (1) registered teacher will be selected at random on March 27, 2013 and awarded two (2) tickets to the IIHF Ice Hockey Women's World Championship Opening night game April 2, 2013 featuring Canada vs. U.S.A

The winning Entrant is solely responsible for all of his or her costs not specifically outlined in this Prize description as being included in the Prize including but not limited to meals, beverages, merchandise, souvenirs, parking and all personal expenses of any kind or nature. The Winning Entrant is also responsible for all costs incurred in travelling to the Women's World Championship game that they have won tickets to attend and returning from that game to his or her place of residence.

Classroom Participation Prize(s)

6. Every Entrant will receive an electronic certificate of participation in April 2013.

Winning Wednesday Puckster Book Draw(s)

- Every Entrant will be eligible for the Winning Wednesday Puckster book draws.
 Winning Wednesday classroom winners will be awarded a set of Puckster books for their school library in English and French.
 - a. Winning Wednesday draws will be executed on February 27, March 6, 13, 20, and 27, 2013 (the "Draw Dates").
 - Winning Wednesday prizing will be drawn at random from the valid Entries received by Hockey Canada prior to the applicable Draw Date.
 - c. Winning classroom teachers will be contacted by phone or email and will have 48 hrs. to respond or the prize will be re-drawn.





Monthly Participation Prize

8. Every Entrant will be eligible for a monthly participation prize consisting of One (1) Signed Team Canada Jersey.

Draws for the monthly participation prize will be executed on (February 28, March 21, April 4) ("the Monthly Draw Dates").

Monthly participation prize selection will be conducted at random from the valid entries received by Hockey Canada prior to the applicable Monthly Draw Date.

- 9. Each set of Puckster books described in sections 7. of these Rules shall include the following:
 - Puckster's First Hockey Tournament by Lorna Schultz Nicholson and Kelly Findley (English & French)
 - ii. Puckster's New Hockey Teammate by Lorna Schultz Nicholson and Kelly Findley (English & French)
- 10. The retail value of the Prize is between \$25-\$150 depending on the nature of the prize that is won.
- 11. The prize must be accepted as awarded. The Prize may not be sold, transferred, exchanged and no component thereof is convertible to cash. The Contest Sponsor is not responsible for and accepts no liability for any portion of the Grand Prize that may be cancelled, rescheduled, delayed, postponed or otherwise affected for any reason.
- 12. The chances of winning any of the prizing depends upon the number of eligible entries received.
- 13. The Contest Sponsor reserves the right to substitute any Prize or a component thereof with a prize or a prize component of equivalent or greater retail value, including, but solely at the Contest Sponsor's discretion, a cash award. By accepting the Prize, the winner agrees to waive all recourse against the Contest Sponsor if the Prize or a component thereof proves unsatisfactory in whole or in part.
- 14. Winners will be chosen by a random draw at Hockey Canada located at 801 King Edward Avenue, Suite N204, Ottawa, Ontario K2N 6N5.
- 15. Following the draw, the Entrant of each selected Winning Classroom will be contacted at the email address and/or telephone number provided on the Entry.
- 16. In order to be declared a winner, the Entrant of the Winning Classroom must;
 - a. Respond to the notification email or telephone call within 48 hours of transmission; and
 - b. Correctly answer, unaided, a time-limited, mathematical skill-testing question.
 - c. Consent to the announcement of the Winning school, classroom, teacher and/or student's name and the use by or on behalf of the Contest Sponsor of the Winning school, classroom, teacher and/or student's name, city of residence, photograph, likeness, voice or statements for advertising and promotional purposes without any further compensation.

If the Entrant fails to comply with the requirements of sections 16a, b, or c a new Entrant will be selected as the winner of that Prize.

Consent to Personal Information Use and Disclosure

17. By entering the Contest, participants consent to the Contest Sponsor's collection, use and disclosure of the personal information provided in Contest entries for the administration of the Contest and in aggregated, non-personal form in order to create reports regarding Contest Entrant demographics. Hockey Canada will adhere to the terms and conditions of their Privacy Policy which can be found at www.hockeycanada.ca.

Disclaimer and Liability Exclusion

- 18. The Contest Sponsor and its employees, officers, directors, volunteers, agents, representatives, successors and assigns, the suppliers of Prizes or services related to the Contest, and their respective advertising, promotion and production agencies and other agents or representatives will not, under any circumstances, be responsible for, or liable to any Contest Entrant or any other person for:
 - a. any erroneous, lost, damaged, late, incomplete, misdirected, deleted, defective, or altered Contest Entry, regardless of the cause;
 - b. any failure for any reason whatsoever of the selected Entrant to receive a prize notification email;
 - c. any changes in email addresses or email address assignments after Contest Entry forms are submitted;
 - d. any computer, online, telephone, or technical malfunctions or errors that may occur, regardless of the cause; or
 - any damage or loss, including any loss of use, loss of production, loss of profits (anticipated or otherwise), loss of markets, economic loss, special,





indirect or consequential loss or damage or punitive damages, whether in contract, tort or under any other theory of law or equity, arising from, connected with, or relating to the Contest or the submission of entries to the Contest or participation in the Contest or the Contest prize, or the use of the HockeyCanada.ca web site (including the downloading of any materials from that web site) and regardless of the cause or any negligence by Contest Sponsor or anyone for whom the Contest

Sponsor is responsible, and notwithstanding that the Contest Sponsor may have been advised or aware of the possibility of such loss or damage being incurred.

19. Winners, by acceptance of any Prize, agree to release the Contest Sponsor and their respective employees, officers, directors, volunteers, agents, representatives, successors and assigns, the suppliers of Prizes or services related to the Contest, and their respective advertising, promotion and production agencies and other agents or representatives from any and all liability, claims or actions of any kind whatsoever for injuries, damages or losses to persons and property which may be sustained in connection with the receipt, ownership or use of a Prize or while preparing for, participating in, and/or traveling to any prize-related activity.

Other Matters

- 20. If for any reason the Contest is not capable of being conducted as intended, including due to computer viruses, bugs, tampering, unauthorized intervention, fraud, technical failures, or any other cause that corrupts or interferes with the administration, security, fairness, integrity or proper conduct of the Contest, the Contest Sponsor may, at its sole discretion, disqualify any Entrant responsible for such misconduct and cancel, terminate, modify, or suspend the Contest.

CAUTION: ANY ATTEMPT TO DELIBERATELY DAMAGE ANY WEB SITE OR INTERFERE WITH THE LEGITIMATE OPERATION OF THE CONTEST MAY BE A VIOLATION OF CRIMINAL AND CIVIL LAWS, AND THE CONTEST SPONSOR RESERVES THE RIGHT TO SEEK DAMAGES AND/OR OTHER RELIEF FROM ALL RESPONSIBLE PERSONS TO THE FULLEST EXTENT PERMITTED BY LAW.
- 22. Return of any Prize notification email as undeliverable may result in disqualification, and an alternate winner may be selected. Any potential Prize winner's refusal or inability to accept a prize awarded shall release the Contest Sponsor from all obligations. In no event shall the Contest Sponsor be required to award more prizes than what is mentioned in the Rules and Regulations or to award prizes otherwise than in compliance with these Rules and Regulations.
- 23. Participation in the Contest constitutes acceptance and agreement to these Contest Rules.
- 24. The Contest Sponsor reserves the right, at its option, to publish any prize winner's name, address, photograph, likeness, voice or statements without any further compensation to the winner.

The Contest Sponsor reserves the right, in its sole and absolute discretion, and without prior notice, to adjust any of the dates and/or timeframes stipulated in these Rules, to the extent necessary, for purposes of verifying compliance by any Entrant with these Rules, or as a result of technical problems, or in light of any other circumstances which, in the opinion of the Contest Sponsor, in its sole and absolute discretion, affect the proper administration of the Contest as contemplated in these Rules.
- 26. The Contest is subject to all applicable federal, provincial and local laws and is void where prohibited by law. If any provision of these Rules is found by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unenforceable, all other provisions will remain in full force and effect. In the event of any discrepancy or inconsistency between the terms and conditions of these Rules and disclosures or any other statements contained in any Contest-related materials, including, but not limited to any entry form, television, print or on-line advertising; the terms and conditions of these Rules shall prevail, govern and control.
