

## Lesson Plan

<b>Title of lesson</b>  <p style="text-align: center;"><b>Careers in Hockey</b></p>	
<b>Purpose</b> <p>The purpose for the following activities is to allow students to learn about and explore occupations connected to the world of hockey.</p>	
<b>Learning outcome(s)</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The students will be able understand the relationship between work and society/economy.</li> <li>The students will be able to understand the changing nature of life/work roles surrounding the game of hockey.</li> </ul>

<b>Pre-test</b> <p>The students with teacher guidance will create occupation webs to see how many careers they can list that are connected to the game of hockey.</p>	
<b>Input from you</b> <p>The teacher will introduce the word search, the crossword and discuss the presented occupations for basic understanding.</p> <p>The students can do further research on the occupations through the world wide web</p>	<b>Guided practice</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Career word search</li> <li>Career crossword</li> <li>Career questionnaire</li> <li>Internet based research involving hockey careers -suggested site <a href="http://www.careercruising.com">www.careercruising.com</a></li> </ul>
<b>Closure</b> <p>Have the students prepare a reflection on a connected hockey occupation that has been discussed and is of interest to the student.</p>	
<b>Check for understanding</b> <p>The answering of the 5w's (who, what, where, when, and why through an oral debrief of the occupations covered throughout the lessons.</p>	
<b>Assessment</b> <p>Have the students conduct research on an occupation connected to hockey of their choice and answer the questions on the career questionnaire.</p>
