INSURANCE

- 1-Hockey Canada insurance programs are in place to protect every player, coach, assistant coach, manager, Hockey Canada Safety Program personnel, official and volunteer involved in Hockey Canada sanctioned hockey activities.
- 2-The insurance programs eliminate or minimize the potential financial burden our members may face in the event that they are injured or implicated in a civil action arising from their participation in Hockey Canada programs.
- *If a HC team plays a non-sanctioned team there is NO insurance coverage. If a HC official does a game involving a non-sanctioned team there is NO insurance coverage.

COMPETITION

- 1-Membership in Hockey Canada through one of its Members will help create access to Hockey Canada sanctioned programming, which may include competition in; the Canadian Sports Schools Hockey League (CSSHL) and other exhibition, league and tournament play.
- 2-Membership will allow competition against US-based teams that are members of USA Hockey.
- 3-While participation in Member Playoffs that lead to Regional or National Championships is restricted, Hockey Canada Accredited School teams will have access to other Member and League competitions, as determined by Member.

- 1-Access for players and coaches to Members and Hockey Canada High Performance programs.
- 2-Access to the Affiliate Player process with the Member.
- 3-Coaching staff must meet coaching certifications as outline by Hockey Canada.
